- SFRC was surveyed April 12-13, 2017. On April 18<sup>th</sup>, the CMA issued an Emergency Notification to Secretary Jones for Inpatient Mental Health Services at SFRC. In response to the Emergency Notification, the Department of Corrections (FDC) provided the CMA with an emergency CAP. The final survey report for SFRC has not been released. Therefore, a full update regarding the SFRC survey and Emergency Notification will be provided at the next Board meeting.

- The survey schedule for fiscal year 2017-2018 is being finalized and will be sent out soon.
